	<p>Posology</p> <p><i>Adolescents, adults and elderly</i></p> <p>a) Single dose:</p> <p>Herbal tea: 2-5 g of the herbal substance or comminuted herbal substance in 150 ml boiling water as a herbal infusion three times daily.</p> <p>Herbal tea: 3-6 g of the comminuted herbal substance in 200 ml water as a decoction divided in 2 single doses daily.</p> <p>b) Single dose: 2-5 ml three times daily</p> <p>c) Single dose: 10-25 ml three times daily</p> <p>The use in children under 12 years of age is not recommended (see section 4.4 'Special warnings and precautions for use').</p> <p>Duration of use</p> <p>If the symptoms persist longer than 1 week during the use of the medicinal product, a doctor or a qualified health care practitioner should be consulted.</p> <p>Method of administration</p> <p>Oral use</p>

	<p>The use in children under 12 years of age has not been established due to lack of adequate data.</p> <p>If the symptoms worsen during the use of the medicinal product, a doctor or a qualified health care practitioner should be consulted.</p> <p>If dyspnoea, fever or purulent sputum occurs, a doctor or a qualified health care practitioner should be consulted.</p> <p>For tinctures and extracts containing ethanol, the appropriate labelling for ethanol, taken from the 'Guideline on excipients in the label and package leaflet of medicinal products for human use', must be included.</p>
